Low St paddock public meeting held on 3rd June - The Council would like to thank everyone who took the time to attend this meeting or contact the Council via letter or email to offer their opinion on this proposed project. We listened carefully to your opinions and discussed all matters raised at our annual meeting, resulting in the Council unanimously resolving not to progress the matter further. It did however; agree to approach the Crown Estate representatives, re several issues/concerns raised about the paddock and have since arranged to meet with them on 22nd June to discuss these concerns further. Given that this aborted project would have been dedicated to our late Queen, we are now looking for something else to do/buy in her memory. So if you have any ideas as to what we can do to commemorate her, please let our clerk know by 8th July.

D Day 80 years celebrations – the Council plans to hold a public meeting in September – (date to be confirmed in our next newsletter) to look at forming a village committee to organise an event to celebrate this landmark. If you have any ideas or would like to form/be part of a committee please let our clerk know by 8th July.

What's happening with the old Aveland School site? LCC still plans to develop this site for housing. However; their planning application expired and to date they have not submitted a new one. So it looks likely that no work will commence this year. We will continue to flowing this up with Cllr Hill and keep you informed accordingly.

Planning - S23/0511 proposed solar farm —the Council **resolved to object.** Whilst on balance the Council is not against the erection of a solar farm, it considered that for the following reasons this was the best course of action - proposal meant there would be a loss of grade 2 arable land, possible flooding due to water run-off, that there was no guarantee re 106 monies going directly to our community, that there are a considerable number of applications currently being considered for this area, that may be on more appropriate land than this and that the traffic management plan was inadequate. **S23/0047** — proposed dwelling on the car park of the Fortescue Arms — it resolved to reiterate its objection to this application with additional comments questioning the validity of the recent arboriculture report. **NB** All planning applications can be viewed in full on SKDC's website.

SKDC local plan – adopted in 2020 committed them to undertake an early review of it. However due to impending changes to the National Policy Framework consultation on the Draft Local Plan has been delayed. Consequently the SKDC local development scheme has been revised to ensure that a timetable for the Local Plan review is realistic and achievable. The revised Local development scheme (2023 -2026) was approved at Cabinet on 30th May 2023 and can be viewed at www.southkesteven.gov.uk/localplanreview. The next stage of the consultation will be on a draft version of the plan this winter.

Public footpath between Billingborough & Pointon – we have been advised by Cllr Martin Hill that LCC intend to repair/reinstate this footpath, which currently is in an abysmal condition.

School crossing patrol attendant – we have been advised by Cllr Martin Hill that our application for an attendant was **SUCCESSFUL!** So we are now looking for someone to take up the post, which is for two hours per day during term time. A job share may be possible. If you're interested in applying for this please contact LCC or the Chair, who will pass your details to them. **NB** this post will be funded by

Jitty between Brewery Lane & Burton Lane – we have been advised by Cllr Martin Hill that LCC have agreed to repair it, though unfortunately we do not have a date as to when this will be. However we will maintain pressure until it is rectified.

Coronation celebrations – the Council would like to thank the village hall committee & BATS for all their hard work to provide the village with a very enjoyable afternoon and fun filled evening. In total they raised £1,043.00 for Lincs & Notts Air Ambulance. We'd also like to thank all those that decorated the church so beautifully! **Thank you!**

You can do this by using 3 random words, avoiding names, pets, birthdays etc. and by adding symbols/numbers. You should always use a different password for every account. Also turn on 2 step verification (2SV) which doubles your protection should a cyber-criminal have your password, most providers have this facility, if not it might be worth changing provider. Services such as www.haveibeenpwned.com can tell you if your personal information or any of your account passwords have been public in a major data breach.
